This is to Certify, That records in the state archives show that

HELGE C. ELLINGBOE, Born in Norway, Residence, Town of Manitowoc, Manitowoc County,  
late a Private in Company F of the 15th Regiment  
of Wisconsin Infantry Volunteers was enlisted  
on the 8th day of November 1861,  
Captain Gustavson at Manitowoc, Wis.,  
for the term of 3 years was mustered into the military service of the United States  
on the 12th day of December 1861,  
at Madison, Wisconsin.

6 to 10/62 Absent, sick at Island, No. 10 since 6/11/62. Discharged  
10/13/62 at Cincinnati, Ohio for disability. Mustered out same (no cause).  
Enlisted as Private in Company K of the 27th Regiment on 20th of September,  
1864 for the term of one year, and mustered in same date; assigned to company  
and 11/7/64, and discharged  
on the 14th day of July, 1865, ~~xx~~ per Governor's order, Hd.Qrs.  
Mil. Div. West Miss, 5/3/65.

(at time of first enlistment)  
The records further show that said soldier when enlisted was 20 / single years of age, single,  
had blue eyes, light hair, light complexion, was 5  
feet 5 inches in height, and by occupation a Farmer.

of Madison, this 2nd day of June,  
in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred 69.
