I CERTIFY, that I have carefully examined the said *Helge C. Ellingbo* of
Captain *C. Gustaverson's* Company, and find him incapable of performing the duties of a soldier because

with great Debility, that commenced 2 to months
ago under a typhoid fever and has in the last
week considerably increased.
